

# Saint Mary's Reading Challenge



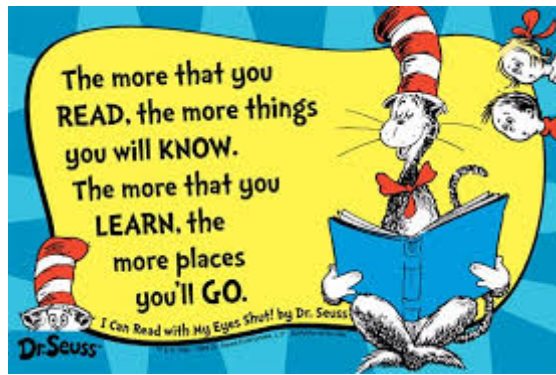
