Enrollment:

- <u>Gr 7 & 8 Immunizations</u>: The Health Unit attended the school on November 9 for Grade 7 & 8 Immunizations. The SMDHU will return to Saint Mary's on May 16, 2023, for the second dose.
- <u>CSCC Chocolate Bar Fundraiser</u>: Thank you to those parents who helped distribute the chocolate bars. Our campaign wraps up this Friday, December 2, 2022
