Peace Garden benches: The account used for the fundraiser for the benches was double checked after the last council meeting, there was a discrepancy. The board office moved the missing funds to the correct account \$697.02. The family who donated the benches was reimbursed through the funds collected. Cheri's benches were locally sourced and cost \$1484.80. The funds raised also paid for two chains and two cinder blocks. The chains and cinder blocks will add an extra layer of protection for the benches.
